

## LEARNING FOCUS 3: God sent Jesus to bring the Good News to everyone.

### CONTENT

After Jesus was baptised by John, he began his mission. Luke tells of Jesus reading from the prophet Isaiah and making clear to everyone what he had come for. In the reading, we are told that Jesus says he has been anointed and specially chosen to bring the good news of justice to our world.

Read *Jesus begins his mission* (Luke 4:14-22). Highlight paragraph 3 '*The Spirit of the Lord .....in any way.*' Pick out and list what Jesus intends to do

### SOME KEY QUESTIONS

- Q How can poverty hold people captive?
- Q What do you think would cause people to be *broken hearted*?
- Q Why do you think Jesus would want to heal the *broken hearted*?
- Q How do you think the people in the synagogue felt when they heard Jesus speak these words?
- Q Who helps us today to understand God's Good News?
- Q What do you think "*Good News*" for our world might be?

### Activity

- Write an article for a school magazine about what the world would look like if all people lived out the Good News of justice Jesus spoke about.

Use the phrase "God sent me to bring the Good News" or the words of the hymn, 'God's Spirit is in my heart' to show the advice could be lived out to make the world a better place.
