

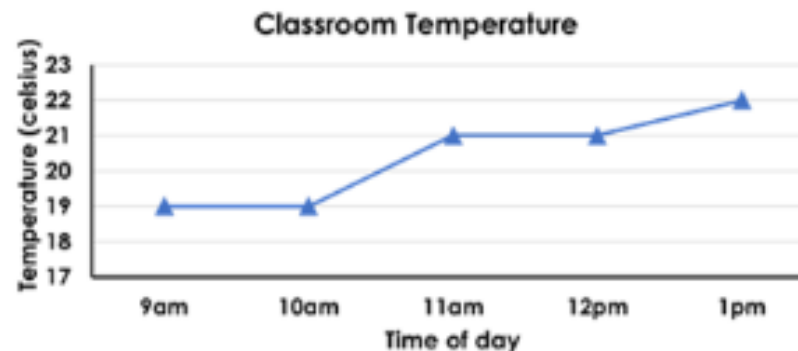

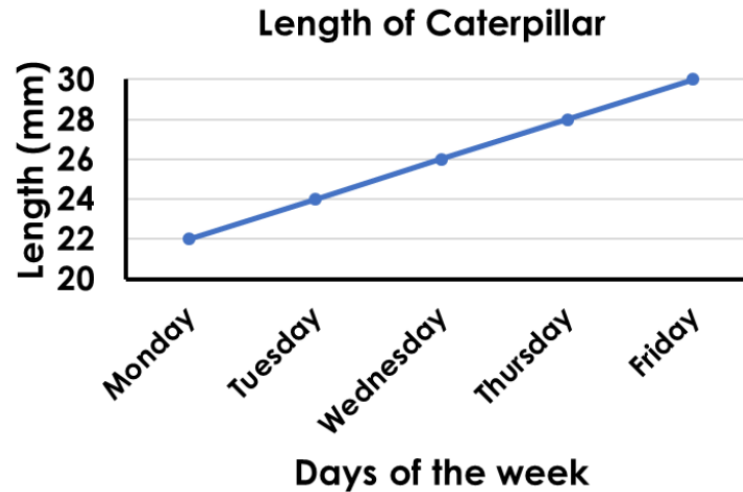

Direct Speech

When we use direct speech in our writing:

The exact words spoken must be put inside speech marks. " "

The first spoken word must have a capital letter.

When a new speaker begins, we must start a new line.

If the direct speech is in the middle of sentence, it usually follows a colon (:) or a comma (,).

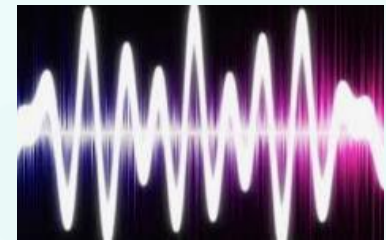
