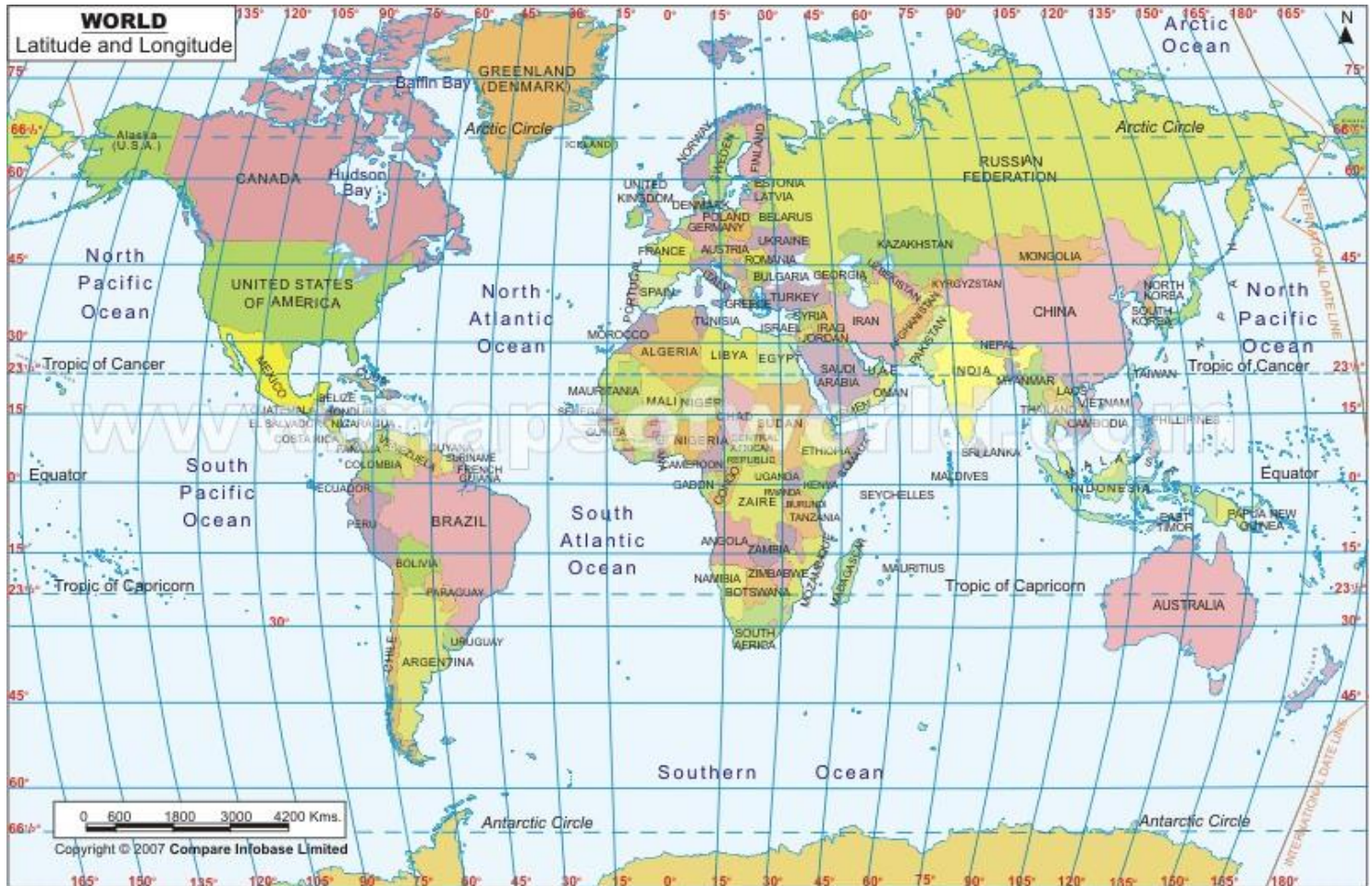


## LO: To use mapping skills

**Latitude:** is the distance of any object from the equator measured in degrees. The distance from the equator to itself is 0, thus the latitude at the equator is 0°. They measure how far North or South an object is on the Earth.

**Longitude:** The lines running vertically around the Earth are called Longitude. These lines are called meridians, and measure how far East or West an object is.
