Science – Shadows

Choose a sunny day to complete this task. If possible, you will need: a toy, object or another person to draw around & some chalk.

*Ask adult permission before you begin to chalk onto the ground somewhere in your garden, yard or on a pavement if it is safe to do so.

In the morning, get someone to stand on the ground or place an object/toy on the ground and draw around it then draw around their/its shadow. Take a note of the time of day. Repeat every hour (or 2 hours) throughout the day and see if and how the shadow changes. If you do not have chalk, stand in the same spot and look carefully at your shadow throughout the day.
