### Week beginning 18<sup>th</sup> May

**RE** We continue our Pentecost topic. Lesson 4: Modern witnesses to the power of the Holy Spirit. Lesson 5: Ourselves as witnesses. Please see the task sheets for details of the activities.

**Maths** – Each day, open the 'Y6 Maths Fluent in Five' document and complete the 5 arithmetic calculations for that day onto paper or a notebook. The answers are provided in the document for you to check afterwards.

### **Geography**

Use <https://www.timeanddate.com/time/map/> to help you complete your geography work. There is a choice of two levels of challenge this week.

For the simpler task, complete 'Y6 Geog time zones worksheet Twinkl' or, if you fancy a real challenge, try 'Y6 Geog calculating using time zones challenge' where you will need to work out the duration of flights from London Heathrow to different destinations and look up the destinations time zone to work out the local arrival time. Good luck!

### **Science – Electricity**

To begin our work on electricity, go to <https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/z2882hv/articles/zcwnv9q> and recap on what you've learnt before about electricity using the 'What is electricity?' and 'What are conductors and insulators?' sections. Each has a short video and is followed by a short task.

Then, continue to look at 'What is power?' and 'How can you change a circuit?' sections. Again, watch the short videos and complete the tasks.
