RE – We continue with our healing topic. Lesson 4: 'The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick during Mass and lesson 5: 'The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick for those who are very ill.' Please see lesson task sheet for further details.

For each day there is a short video to watch online. The worksheet and answers can be found on the school website. **This week please do Summer Term - Week 8 (w/c 22nd June) which focuses on geometry.**

English – Remember when we did some excellent chronological reports on elephants? We are going to revisit this topic and write a non-chronological report on an alien hotel resort. Work your way through the PPT. There is a planning sheet and model write to help support you in your writing.

Geography – This lesson focuses on longitude and latitude. The geography worksheet gives an overview of these terms. Use the image provided to help answer questions related to longitude and latitude.

Science – We begin a new topic ‘Living things and their habitats’. Use the PPT provided to find out about classification. Classification Conundrum: You will act as taxonomists to classify animals for a new zoo, by sorting and grouping the animals on the differentiated Zoo Animals List, using the differentiated Zoo Classification Activity Sheet as a guide.
