**RE/Geography** – Our final RE topic links in with geography and caring for our world. This week, use the link provided to consider the greenhouse effect.

**Maths** – Each day, open the 'Y6 Maths Flashback 4 area, perimeter and volume warm ups' document and complete the 4 quick recap questions for that day onto paper or a notebook. The answers are provided in the document for you to check afterwards.

**English** – This week there are three story writing prompts. Use these to create your own stories. You may wish to devise your own purpose and structure grid/success criteria to help or go straight into writing. There are some grammar activities (see PPTs) to recap some of the techniques that we have explored over our time in Year 6.

If you wish to hone your comprehension skills, there is also a reading comprehension to complete.

**Science** – We continue the ‘Living things and their habitats’ topic. Use the PPT provided to find out about the Linnaean system and complete the activity sheets.
