Second Decade: The Visitation of Mary to Elizabeth (Luke 1:39-56) FRUIT: LOVE OF NEIGHBOR **Third Decade:** The Birth of Our Lord (Luke 2:1-21) FRUIT: POVERTY

Fourth Decade: The Presentation of Our Lord (Luke 2:22-38) FRUIT: OBEDIENCE **Fifth Decade:** The Finding of Our Lord in the Temple (Luke 2:41-52) FRUIT: JOY IN FINDING JESUS

On Thursday, meditate on the "Luminous Mysteries" | First Decade: The Baptism of Our Lord in the River Jordan (Matthew 3:13-17) FRUIT: OPENNESS TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

Second Decade: The Wedding at Cana, when Christ manifested Himself (Jn 2:1-11) FRUIT: TO JESUS THROUGH MARY

Third Decade: The Proclamation of the Kingdom of God (Mark 1:14-15) FRUIT: REPENTANCE AND TRUST IN GOD **Fourth Decade:** The Transfiguration of Our Lord (Matthew 17:1-8) FRUIT: DESIRE FOR HOLINESS

Fifth Decade: The Last Supper, when Our Lord gave us the Holy Eucharist (Mt 26: 26-30) FRUIT: ADORATION

On Tuesday and Friday, meditate on the "Sorrowful Mysteries" | First Decade: The Agony of Our Lord in the Garden (Matthew 26:36-56) FRUIT: SORROW FOR OUR SINS

Second Decade: Our Lord is Scourged at the Pillar (Matthew 27:26) FRUIT: PURITY **Third Decade:** Our Lord is Crowned with Thorns (Matthew 27:27-31) FRUIT: COURAGE

Fourth Decade: Our Lord Carries the Cross to Calvary (Matthew 27:32) FRUIT: PATIENCE **Fifth Decade:** The Crucifixion of Our Lord (Matthew 27:33-56) FRUIT: PERSEVERANCE

On Wednesday and Sunday, meditate on the "Glorious Mysteries" | First Decade: The Glorious Resurrection of Our Lord (John 20:1-29) FRUIT: FAITH

Second Decade: The Ascension of Our Lord (Luke 24:50-53) FRUIT: HOPE **Third Decade:** The Descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost (Acts 2:1-41) FRUIT: LOVE OF GOD

Fourth Decade: The Assumption of Mary into Heaven FRUIT: GRACE OF A HAPPY DEATH **Fifth Decade:** The Coronation of Mary as Queen of Heaven and Earth FRUIT: TRUST IN THE INTERCESSION OF MARY
