

Trip costs: Prices are rising, coach costs are a significant cause. Teachers will do their best to provide information about a trip as early as possible. This will allow at least a 2-part payment to be setup for families who wish to spread the cost of the trip over a few months.



Residentials: Parents attending the meeting agreed they value these trips (Y5 Perlethorpe, Y6) The Briars) but were concerned about the cost. The monthly payments are beneficial and following the meeting, the school will contact local Nottingham businesses to see if any can offer financial support.


Parent Forum – Continued

Celebration Assembly timings: The general feel, from parents / carers

who attended the forum, was that mornings are better for parents. After Christmas, school will arrange the Celebration assemblies for a **Thursday morning - 9am** (January 2024), in hope it enables a greater number of parents to attend. Friday mornings would be favoured, but across the school we are busy with Music lessons each week. We will reflect again if Thursday mornings are not successful. I am keen for this to be an opportunity for parents to come and spend time together, if you wish, whether your child is being celebrated or not. Let's see how Thursdays go.

Connecting with the Parish: I mentioned that we are trying to make stronger links with St Mary's and St Paul's parish at the meeting. Leaflets have been provided to invite the parishioners to our Christmas celebrations. I am so grateful and delighted with the response for those joining us next Sunday – the First Sunday of Advent at St Mary's Church. More than 80 children are coming!! I am so looking forward to this occasion.

Nativity Performances: It was requested that we film the KS1 nativity and EYFS songs so that parents / carers are not required to use mobile phones to video the performances, which is never a good sight from the children's perspective. I need everyone's permission for this to happen. Staff will talk to parents /carers where there is a concern, to ensure we have permission and we hope to upload the performances on to our YouTube channel for people to view.



Communication: It was requested that school use text messaging more often instead of emails for communicating with parents. The office use text messages sparingly as they are expensive. 10 000 messages cost £480. This is equivalent to a whole school message being sent on 40 occasions. The messages cannot sometimes be simplified and therefore require 2 credits for each family, therefore 20 on some occasions.

The office use text messages where there is a **high** priority message. Please make sure you are checking your emails and record the dates on the diary above, to ensure you are well informed regarding school events. Text message are only used for last minute changes and a phone call is often used instead on such occasions. We welcome any feedback.
