

It is important that your child reads at home for **5-10 minutes every night**. Please write in the reading diary when you have listened to your child read. For the reading system to work, it is crucial that the children then read with parents at home and be able to read the book fluently.

- Read, write and apply digraphs and trigraphs
- Form letters correctly and with good control over size.
- Read and write sentences and begin to use full stops and capital letters
- Read 'Tricky words' automatically.
- Hold a pencil correctly.
